Information About Literature In Polling Places:

Voters may feel free to bring in literature to use in the voting booths that will help them in making their choices. Voters are not allowed to leave their literature in the voting booths after they have voted.

Information About Cell Phones, Cameras, and Recording Devices In Polling Places:

The use of cell phones, cameras, and video and sound recording devices is prohibited in polling places. This includes using cell phones to look up information on candidates and using cell phones to take pictures.

Information About Campaigning In or Around Polling Places:

No campaign signs, buttons, apparel, hats, or shirts are allowed in polling places. No campaigning is allowed within 100 feet of a polling place.

Election Night Information:

A public waiting area will be open at 7:00 p.m. on Election Night in the Courthouse Annex for the media and voters who want to receive printouts of election results as soon as they are available. Early Voting results will be released around 7:00 p.m. Final results are estimated to be available by 10:00 p.m.

Public Test Information:

A public test of the electronic voting equipment to be used in the November 8, 2016 Nacogdoches County General Election will take place at 4:30 p.m. on Friday, September 30, 2016 in the Elections Office located within the Courthouse Annex Building 6 203 W. Main St. 6 Nacogdoches, TX 75961.
