

# Information *for the* November 8, 2016 Martinsville I.S.D. School Board Election

## **General Information:**

Registered voters in the Martinsville I.S.D. jurisdiction will be eligible to vote in the November 8th, 2016 Martinsville I.S.D. School Board Election.

The last day to register to vote for the Martinsville I.S.D. School Board Election is Tuesday, October 11th, 2016. All applications must be postmarked or received by the Nacogdoches County Elections Office by this date.

To qualify to vote by mail you must be 65 years of age or older, or have a disability, or be confined in jail, or be able to provide an address outside of Nacogdoches County if you will not be in Nacogdoches County during voting times. The last day for the Elections Office to accept/receive applications for mail ballots is Friday, October 28th, 2016.

A public test of the electronic voting equipment to be used in the November 8, 2016 Martinsville I.S.D. School Board Election will take place at 4:30 p.m. on Friday, September 30th, 2016 in the Elections Office located within the Courthouse Annex Building ó 203 W. Main St. ó Nacogdoches, TX 75961.
