#### Largemouth Bass

- Definite lateral stripe
- Jaw extends well behind the back margin of the eye when mouth is closed.

## **Guadalupe and Spotted Bass**

• Irregular lateral stripe is similar to, but more broken than in largemouth bass. Spots on scales form "rows" of strips

#### **Channel Catfish**

on whitish belly area.

- Body with dark spots (spots may be
- absent in large adults) Outer margin of anal fin rounded, and anal fin with 24 to 29 rays

### Blue Catfish

- Body without dark spots
- Outer margin of anal fin straight, and anal fin with 30 to 36 rays

- Black Crappie Irregular black blotches on the sides
- Dorsal fin with seven or eight spines

## White Crappie

- Vertical barring along the sides
- Dorsal fin with a maximum of six spines

- Dark spot at the base of the dorsal fin
- Vertical barring along the sides
- Anal fin has 3 spines
