Early Voting Starts Today

Early voting opens today and runs through November 1st.

Nacogdoches County will be conducting a State Constitutional Amendment Election and a Special Election for the City of Nacogdoches. All registered voters in Nacogdoches County are eligible to vote in the State Constitutional Amendment Election. Registered voters who live within the City of Nacogdoches are eligible to vote in the Special Election.

Early Voting will be conducted in the Elections Office within the Courthouse Annex building located at 203 W. Main St., Room #113, Nacogdoches, TX 75961. The dates and hours for voting are as follows:

Oct. 21, 2013 through Oct. 25, 2013 – Daily from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Oct. 28, 2013 through Oct. 30, 2013 – Daily from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Oct. 31, 2013 through Nov. 1, 2013 – Daily from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
