### Nacogdoches County Burn Ban Lifted

Today in a special meeting of the Commissioner's Court, the Burn Ban for Nacogdoches County was officially lifted. **Even though the burn ban has been lifted the residents of Nacogdoches County still need to be cautious.** There still may be a risk of wild fires and brush fires if not careful.

#### Things to remember:

- Keep a phone handy so you can call 911 if your fire gets out of hand.
- Don't burn on a windy day.
- Stay with your fire until it's out.
- Keep your fire a manageable size.
- Make sure that the area is safe to burn in. Clear away dried leaves, grass and other fuel sources that can cause your fire to spread.
- Keep your fire far from other's homes or property for safety.
- Only burn wood, limbs, or leaves.
- Have a water hose available and do not leave a fire unattended.
- Extinguish the coals or fire completely with water once you are finished.
