

**ORDER OF THE COURT REGARDING FILE-MARK AND RULE 24**

It was brought to the attention of the Court that newly-elected and now current County Clerk Sandy Yates has taken office without having yet obtaining the engraving plates, equipment, and/or electronic means of replacing the former Clerk's name/signature. Such equipment has been sought and/or requested, but has not been made available and put into use.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that, until appropriate equipment, technology, and/or engraving plates have been obtained and put into use, County Clerk Sandy Yates shall use the existing and available file-marking mechanisms and/or equipment and strike the name of the former Clerk by hand and replace by hand the signature of the current Clerk and initial the same. Any altering of the file-mark pursuant to this Order shall not be considered an alteration to any document or instrument, but only a means of complying with laws of this State. This Order shall remain in effect until the new means of applying a file-mark is obtained and put into use.
