10 Acre Rule

A System is exempt from permitting if it serves a single family residence on a continuous tract of land that is 10 acres or larger and is the only single family residence on that tract of land and is not required to have a permit from the local permitting authority.

Exceptions to the 10 Acre Rule –

- 1) ANRA does not follow the 10 acre rule and there are some areas in Nacogdoches County that fall in this area. We can't permit in this area.
- 2) No 10 Acre exemption will be allowed regardless of acreage within 2000 feet of the Elevation 286 mean sea level on Lake Nacogdoches and elevation 357 mean sea level on Lake Naconiche
