<u>Prop. #1</u>	Prop 1: Global language changes from "City Commission" to "City Council" and from "At Large" to "Mayor" be amended for all references in the charter.

<u>Prop. #2</u>	Prop 2: Article II "Corporate Powers", Section 15. "Street Powers" be amended to read: No assessment for improvements of any street may be assessed without prior notice to the owners of all property within the limits of the proposed improvement, which notice must specify with reasonable certainty the location, nature, and estimated cost of the proposed improvement, the proposed basis for division of assessment, and the time when the Commission will conduct a public hearing on the proposal. Such notice shall be in writing to each owner and delivery shall be made at least ten days before the hearing. After the hearing, the Commission shall determine by resolution whether the proposed assessment for improvements shall be made. If the Commission approves the assessment for the improvements, construction of the improvements shall begin no later than six months after the resolution is passed.

<u>Prop. #4</u>	Prop 4: Article IV "The City Commission", Section 11 "Meeting of the Commission" be amended to read: The office of City Commissioner, including the At Large City Commissioner, shall become vacant upon the Commissioner's death, resignation, removal from office, or forfeiture of office in any manner required by this Charter or State law. If any Commissioner shall file as a candidate for nomination or election to public office, except to some office under this Charter, that Commissioner shall immediately forfeit his office as Commissioner. A vacancy on the City Commission shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term, if any, at the next available uniform election date following the occurrence of the vacancy; however, if the vacancy occurs more than 30 days before the next available uniform election date then, the City Commission by a majority vote of all its remaining members shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy until the position is filled by election. The City Commission may appoint from among its members.
