

What are the boxes on my Voter Registration Certificate?

On the Left side of your Voter Registration Certificate:

VUID – Voter Unique Identifier. Also referred to as your %voter Number+.

Precinct – This is your Voting Precinct. There are 4 County Commissioner Precincts. Each County Commissioner Precinct is further divided into Voting Precincts.

Voting Precincts 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 are in County Commissioner Precinct 1.

Voting Precincts 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27 are in County Commissioner Precinct 2.

Voting Precincts 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 are in County Commissioner Precinct 3.

Voting Precincts 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, and 47 are in County Commissioner Precinct 4.

Valid From/To Dates – You do not have to re-register to vote every 2 years. Your voter registration will automatically be renewed and you will be sent a new Voter Registration Certificate every 2 years. Voter Registration Certificates expire at the end of odd numbered years. Typically you will receive your new Voter Registration Certificate for an upcoming even numbered year in November or December of the odd numbered year that your current certificate is about to expire for. The only time you need to re-register to vote is if you have had any change to your residential or mailing address.

On the Right side of your Voter Registration Certificate:

USREP – United States Representative District. All of Nacogdoches County is in **District 1**.

Counties in United States Representative District 1 include Angelina, Gregg, Harrison, Nacogdoches, Panola, Rusk, Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, Smith, part of Upshur, and part of Wood.

STSEN – State Senator District. All of Nacogdoches County is in **District 3**.

Counties in State Senator District 3 include Anderson, Angelina, Cherokee, Hardin, Henderson, Houston, Jasper, Liberty, Part of Montgomery, Nacogdoches, Newton, Orange, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, Trinity, Tyler

STREP – State Representative District. All of Nacogdoches County is in **District 11**.

Counties in State Representative District 11 include Cherokee, Nacogdoches, and Rusk.

SBE – State Board of Education District. All of Nacogdoches County is in **District 9**.

Counties in State Board of Education District 9 include Anderson, Angelina, Bowie, Camp, Cass, Cherokee, Delta, Fannin, Franklin, Grayson, Gregg, Harrison, Henderson, Hopkins, Hunt, Kaufman, Lamar, Marion, Morris, Nacogdoches, Panola, Rains, Red River, Rockwall, Rusk, Shelby, Smith, Titus, Upshur, Van Zandt, and Wood.

COMM or JP – County Commissioner Precinct/Justice of the Peace Precinct. There are four County Commissioner Precincts (**1, 2, 3, or 4**). In Nacogdoches County, the boundaries of these four County Commissioner Precincts are the same for Justice of the Peace Precincts, Constable Precincts, and Hospital District Precincts.

CITY – If your residence is within the city limits of one of the five cities in Nacogdoches County, this box will appear on your Voter Registration Certificate. **APP** for Appleby, **CHI** for Chireno, **CUS** for Cushing, **GAR** for Garrison, and **NAC** for Nacogdoches.

SMCITY – City Single Member District. Most often referred to as **%Ward+**. If your residence is within the City of Nacogdoches, this box will appear on your Voter Registration Certificate. The City of Nacogdoches is divided into 4 Wards. **NE** for Northeast Ward, **NW** for Northwest Ward, **SE** for Southeast Ward, and **SW** for Southwest Ward.

SCHL – School District. There are nine school districts in Nacogdoches County. **CISD** for Chireno ISD, **CHISD** for Central Heights ISD, **CUISD** for Cushing ISD, **DISD** for Douglass ISD, **EISD** for Etoile ISD, **GISD** for Garrison ISD, **MISD** for Martinsville ISD, **NISD** for Nacogdoches ISD, and **WISD** for Woden ISD.

SMSCH – Single Member School District. If your residence is within Nacogdoches ISD, this box will appear on your Voter Registration Certificate. Nacogdoches ISD is divided into five Single Member Districts. **SMD1, SMD2, SMD3, SMD4, and SMD5.**

Other Jurisdictions

These jurisdictions do not appear on Voter Registration Certificates because there is not enough room, but at times there may be ballot contests for these jurisdictions.

12th Court of Appeals District – Counties in the 12th Court of Appeals District include Anderson, Angelina, Cherokee, Gregg, Henderson, Houston, Nacogdoches, Rains, Rusk, Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, Smith, Trinity, Upshur, Van Zandt, and Wood.

ESD – Emergency Service District. Nacogdoches County has five Emergency Service Districts. **ESD1, ESD2, ESD3, ESD4, and ESD6.** ESD5 was proposed to voters in 2010, but did not pass.

MUD – Municipal Utility District. There is one Municipal Utility District in Nacogdoches County, Municipal Utility District No. 1, **MUD1.** This district covers County Roads 5021, 5022, 5023, 5024, 5025, and 5026.
