Code of Criminal Procedure Article 45.051 Suspension of Sentence and Deferral of Final Disposition

1) The defendant must enter a plea of no contest or guilty and make a request to the Court for Deferred Disposition.

2) The request must be made by the appear date on the ticket.

3) If you are under 25 years of age and request Deferred Disposition, you will be required to attend a Driver's Safety Course per State Law.

4) You are NOT eligible for Deferred Disposition if you hold a CDL (Commercial Driver's License)

5) There will be a special expense fee in addition to State court costs.

6) The Court may order a disposition deferred up to 90 days.

7.) When all requirements are met the defendant may be granted a Deferred Disposition after the deferral period ends.
